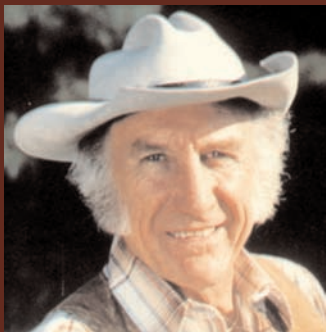

Filming for this highly instructional series took place in the field, during actual hunts, so that you can see how the instruction is successfully implemented.

The magnificently feathered Ringneck Pheasant has become one of North America's most popular gamebirds ... and with good reason. It is beautiful, challenging, and it's **delicious**. Wild populations

of this spectacular bird are now found in 36 states and in Canada, all beginning with a few birds released in Oregon in the late 1800's.

Join Grits Gresham as he hunts several locations in South Dakota, then finishes up at Sandanona, the oldest hunting preserve in the United States. Grits discusses clothes, accessories, shotguns, shot size, and chokes, but most of the video is about how to hunt various types of habitat. You'll receive tips to improve your success and to increase the enjoyment of your time in the field ... by yourself, with your dog, or with fellow hunters.

In South Dakota, Dick and Mike Kuchera take Grits on several different types of hunts: organized drives without dogs, small groups with and without a dog, and even a solitary stroll. And in upstate New York, George Bednar and Gary Hall spend a beautiful Fall day with Grits as they hunt with both pointers and flushing dogs.

For entertainment and education, Sportsmen on Film provides the excitement, the action, and the information.
